By Rail

There is a train station in Kendal which is Kendal is on the branch line between Oxenholme and Windermere. Oxenholme is on the main line and has far more trains than Kendal. It about 2 miles from Kendal town centre so either a change to local train or short taxi ride. Trains run direct to Kendal from London however most other stations do have one or two changes.
