

## **INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL**

### **Manchester Airport**

Manchester is serviced by Manchester international airport [www.manchesterairport.co.uk](http://www.manchesterairport.co.uk) which 81 airlines fly into.

### **Airport Transfer**

Manchester Airport is 12 miles from Manchester City Centre, which is easily accessible from the airport.

#### *By train*

There is a train station at the Airport and trains run every 10-15 minutes. Tickets cost approx £5.80 for a return ticket. Take a train to either Manchester Piccadilly (the main train station for the City Centre) or Manchester Oxford Road Station. Oxford Road station is (slightly) closer to the Festival Centre. The train journey will take about 20 minutes.

#### *By Bus*

The Skyline Stagecoach no. 43 runs from early morning until late at night.

#### *By Taxi*

There is a taxi rank at Manchester Airport. A taxi to the city centre will cost approximately £15. The taxi journey to the city centre will take approximately 20 - 30 minutes, depending on traffic.

### **Liverpool John Lennon Airport**

Easyjet and Ryanair both fly to Liverpool John Lennon Airport from 11 domestic and European destinations making it a good option for many European travellers. John Lennon Airport is approx 1.30hrs travel from Manchester.

### **Airport Transfer**

Liverpool is 30 miles from Manchester city centre.

#### *By Bus*

The quickest and cheapest way to get to Manchester from Liverpool Airport is by bus from outside the airport. The Arriva Airlink 700 express service takes

75 minutes. The bus operates every hour departing Liverpool John Lennon Airport on the half hour. The service operates from early morning until 11pm.

**Eurostar travel**

The Eurostar arrives into London St Pancras; you are then only a 5min walk to Euston station where there are trains to Manchester every hour. We advance you book train tickets to Manchester prior to arrival as advance single tickets cost £12.
